Only pets under the control of a responsible person may be brought to the clinic. Dogs <u>MUST</u> be on a leash. Cats and ferrets <u>MUST</u> be in a cage or tightly secured box with air holes. If a cage/carrier is not available cats <u>MUST</u> be carried in a pillowcase or suitable cloth sack. No other animals will be vaccinated.

first series has been completed.

Ferrets Must be vaccinated every year

*Maryland State Law requires all dogs, cats & ferrets over the age of 4 months to be vaccinated against rabies
