




### Comparison of Jurisdiction Age-adjusted Death Rates\* for All Causes with the Maryland State Rate, 2017-2019








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### 2022 County Health Rankings for the 24 Ranked Counties in Maryland



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#### Children in Poverty in Garrett County, MD County, state and national trends







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### **SCHOOL READINESS**

This year, children across the state received the highest average scores in physical well-being and motor development and social foundations. This is consistent with scale scores from the previous KRA administration in 2019–2020.

### READINESS BY JURISDICTION

The 2021-2022 KRA data show:


- All 24 jurisdictions reported lower demonstrating readiness scores than in 2019–2020.
- Ten jurisdictions, representing over 29,000 kindergarteners, scored below the statewide average for demonstrating readiness.
- Howard, Kent, Talbot, Washington, and Worcester Counties demonstrated a decline in overall readiness of 5% or less, the smallest declines statewide.




### **Infant Mortality Rate** Per 1,000 Live Births











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



The long term trend in Garrett County is getting better for this measure. However, in recent years the trend has worsened.



#### Dentists in Garrett County, MD County, state and national trends








#### Uninsured in Garrett County, MD County, state and national trends




