MARIJUANA LEGALIZED

Both recreational and medical use of cannabis is legal, but there are still laws surrounding its use. Stay up to date on the latest guidance.



Adults 21+ may legally use and possess the "Personal Use" amount of cannabis.

WHAT AMOUNT IS LEGAL?

"Personal Use" amounts:

• Up to 1.5 ounces cannabis

 Up to 2 cannabis plants
Possession in excess of the above amounts is illegal.

WHERE TO CONSUME?

Cannabis can only be consumed on private property - no public spaces allowed.



Adults 21+ are allowed to grow up to two cannabis plants at home. No more than two cannabis plants can be grown per residence.

ARETT COUNT



It is illegal for drivers to consume cannabis in motor vehicles. Driving under the influence can lead to a DUI.



Cannabis remains illegal under federal law. Do not transport cannabis across any state lines.
