Re: 2024 Virtual At-Grade Mound Renewal Courses

The Maryland Department of the Environment will be offering the training for the At-Grade Mound renewal course virtually. Each training will be limited to 35 individuals. Only one half day training session is necessary to extend your At-Grade Mound certification, attendance will be based on ability to visually observe attendees during these live events. This course is only available for contractors who have previously taken and passed the At-Grade Mound construction course.
